Greetings from grades 3-6,

As the year is coming to an end, the third-sixth grade students are preparing to present "book talks". A book talk is a project in which each student chooses a book to read, summarizes the main events in their own words and then presents it to their classmates without telling the ending of the book. The goal is to entice others to read the book as well. The book talks are a good culminating Language Arts activity for the students as their work will be graded on the use of proper English, punctuation, capitalization and how well they wrote the story's main events in their own words. In Social Studies, the third and fourth graders have studied the regions of the United States and are finishing up with a study of the Midwest region. The fifth and sixth grade students have been studying American history this year as the education standards require teaching about the time before Columbus up until the Revolutionary War. The students studied the thirteen colonies and are now learning about the war that eventually gave us independence from Britain and the formation of the United States. It has been a great year with these children. I have enjoyed their personalities, comments, stories, work effort and, especially, their respectful attitudes. This is a wonderful group of students, and I am very proud of them.
