SCS News Principal: Diane Edwards SCS has completed the 2021-2022 school year. We are blessed to have the support of so many for the strong foundation we are giving our preschool-6th grade students. This year we had 35 students in preschool-6th grade. We had two 6th graders "graduate" on June 3. As of right now, we have 38 students enrolled for the 2022-2023 school year. We are meeting with some potential families and are hopeful to increase our numbers before the end of summer.

As a school community, we were thrilled to bring families back into the school for events that were on hold due to COVID. We held Advent and Lent family events with suppers. There were several religion/music programs for families to attend under the direction of Mrs. Lea Nowak. We are excited to continue events as we move into next year.
