The Magnificat

The *Magnificat*, taken from Luke's Gospel (1:46-55), is the Blessed Virgin Mary's hymn of praise to the Lord. It is also known as the Canticle of Mary in the Liturgy of the Hours, a special collection of scripture readings, psalms, and hymns that constitute what is known as the prayer of the church. (Priests and other religious are required to pray sections from the Liturgy of the Hours each day.) As St. Ambrose once said in referring to this wonderful prayer, "Let Mary's soul be in us to glorify the Lord; let her spirit be in us that we may rejoice in God our Saviour."

My soul magnifies the Lord

And my spirit rejoices in God my Savior;

Because He has regarded the lowliness of His handmaid;

For behold, henceforth all generations shall call me blessed;

Because He who is mighty has done great things for me,

and holy is His name;

A Word from Fr. Havel...

Parishioners of the Tri-Parish:

Each year the Diocese of Winona-Rochester has an appeal (Catholic Ministries Appeal) to help fund five areas of ministry within our diocese. The monies collected in this appeal can only be used for the outreach designated by the Catholic Foundation of the diocese.

The areas of outreach supported by the appeal are:

1.) Communications 2.) Vocations Discernment 3.) Faith Formation & Youth Ministry Programs 4.) Catholic Schools 5.) Marriage and Family Life.

During these next two weeks I will be sharing some of the work that these areas support.

Communications: The printing and distribution of our diocesan paper (The Courier) keeps people connected to a broader church. The weekly bulletin shares the activities of our parishes while The Courier brings in diocesan news. Also supported by the appeal is the Mass broadcast on television. It has amazed me in my years of ministry how many of our people watch the Mass on television because it sometimes becomes impossible for them to be at the church. It is a great gift we offer to others, but in order to cover the entire diocesan area, from Soiux Falls, SD, to LaCrosse, WI, it unfortunately means quite a bit of cost.

Vocations Discernment: We are very blessed in the Tri-Parish in having three, of approximately fifteen, diocesan seminarians coming from the Tri-Parish. Ezra Lippert, Brian Klein, and Isaiah Lippert are discerning whether or not the priesthood is where God is leading them. Please pray for them as they discern their vocations. To be ordained as a priest requires eight years of prayer and study. There are four years of college and four years of Theology school. There is a cost to educate and prepare these men who will be serving as priests in our parishes. May they always know the blessings of God and the prayers and support of our parishes.

Next week I will share the other three areas supported by the appeal. If you haven't yet chosen to be a part of the appeal, I invite you to take a pledge card found at the end of the pew. Take it home, fill it out, bring it back next week (put it in the collection basket) and we will send it in. Thank you to all who have supported the appeal already.
