

## MCCW MINUTES

Monday, October 22, 2018 7:00 P.M.

Held in Easton Community Room (due to storm damage to Church)

The Mount Carmel Catholic Women's meeting was called to order by President Marjorie Chaffee. A prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel was led by Marjorie.

The secretary and treasurer reports were read and approved. A thank you card from the USC post prom committee was read thanking MCCW for their donation.

### OLD BUSINESS

### NEW BUSINESS

**Holiday Dessert & Bake Sale** – Discussion held on whether to cancel, hold some other fund raiser, or wait for Church to reopen and have something at that time. Idea was presented to have just a bake sale during Santa Claus Day on Sunday, Dec. 2. After a call was made giving MCCW permission to do this, a motion was made, seconded and carried to proceed with this plan. Notice for the bake sale will be posted in the Church bulletin several weeks ahead of time.

**Honors Sunday** – All in agreement that it is important to have this. Will check with St. John's to see if they would be interested in joining the two parishes for this.

With the closing of St. Peter Lutheran Church, Jane Paul thought it would be nice to give a donation toward their cemetery. A motion made and seconded to give a \$100 donation. President Marjorie commented that changes should be made regarding the MCCW groups for next year. A motion to adjourn the meeting was made, seconded and passed. The meeting adjourned at 8:05 P.M.
