SCS News

Greetings from the K-6 music room! I would like to mention some important dates that are coming up for the students. We have started working on songs for our Veterans Day program which will be held on Monday, November 11, at 2 p.m. in Fr. Mikolai Hall. Then on December 15, at 4 p.m. we will be joining the St. Casimir Church Choir for Lessons and Carols. This is something the choir, school and myself are really excited about.

In K-1st grade music we are learning about the different percussion instruments and are currently learning with boomwhackers. The boomwhackers are lightweight, hollow, colored plastic tubes that teach them the difference between high and low sounds. Along with learning different tones of pitch, the students are beginning to read music while playing them as well.

In 2nd-3rd grade music we are reviewing quarter notes, quarter rests, staff, and measure. In the last two weeks we have started learning how to play the recorders.

In 4th-6th grade music we are working on music theory, learning how to read music and play the hand bells. Each month throughout the school year the students will be learning about a different composer. Last month they learned about Beethoven. This month we are learning about Mozart.
