### From Fr. Havel...

Dear Tri-Parish Parishioners,

Today we celebrate Pentecost. It is the fulfillment of Jesus' promise of the coming of the Holy Spirit. It is the Holy Spirit that empowers us to live as the divine children of God. The power of God's love truly dispels the darkness and fears of our lives and world and leads us into ways of holiness and truth. Come, Holy Spirit!

Lots of changes are going on in our lives. Even though we can begin coming back together as God's people, please be mindful of the restrictions that we need to live by. It may take us a few weeks to figure things out. Please be patient.

- 1. Attendance is limited to 25% of the church's capacity. St. John the Baptist = 65 people; St. Casimir = 125 people; Our Lady of Mt. Carmel = 100 people. We cannot exceed these numbers and when they are reached, no others can come into the church. \*Please remember that the dispensation about Sunday Mass attendance is still in effect.
- 2. As you enter the church, please use hand sanitizer and put on your face mask. Keep six feet separation at all times.
- 3. Please stay in your own parish and do not invite guests. The reason for this is that if people want to go to for example, St. John the Baptist for a vigil Mass, it can quickly be filled and parishioners will be turned away. Help one another.
- 4. Instructions will be given during Mass but also be mindful there will be no singing of Mass parts, books in pews, or signs of peace.
- 5. Also, please know that for everyone's safety, we will sanitize the church after and before every Mass.

One more note: I have become aware of a scam involving my name. Emails asking for gift cards are being sent to people. Please know that I will <u>never</u> ask for this to be done. If you ever receive an email from Fr. Havel asking for money in any form, please delete it immediately.
