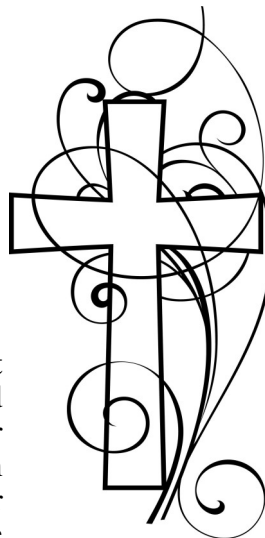

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). The Eucharist that we celebrate is God's gift of Jesus that nourishes us and unites us to the Lord. As Catholics, we believe that Jesus was serious when he said, "For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink." Jesus also says, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you." The Eucharist we celebrate is God's perpetual gift of His son, Jesus. May this gift of God always strengthen us to live faith-filled, holy lives.

One of the parts of Scripture that has always meant a lot to me is when Jesus tells the people that, "My body is real food and my blood is real drink." We are told that many of his followers found this too hard to believe and they left him. Jesus then turns to the apostles and asks if they too want to leave. Peter, for the twelve, simply responds, "To whom would we go? Only you have the words of everlasting life." Jesus, in teaching about his body and blood, did not call the others back or change the teaching. He simply seems to say, here is the truth. Accept it if you are able. Come, Lord Jesus.
