Why do Catholics genuflect in Church? The genuflection is a sign of respect to God and humility in our lives. It is an acknowledgement that we are not God's equal and as we come into the presence of the Lord we lower (humble) ourselves. We genuflect to the Blessed Sacrament (the Body of Christ) present in the Tabernacle. Often in the Scriptures we read how people coming into God's presence would prostrate themselves before the Lord. We too do so each time we come into the Lord's presence by making a profound genuflection.
