

Life is great. This past Wednesday we had our NET retreat in Wells for grades 7-12. We had over 60 kids. It was awesome to see them respond to the NET team and the lessons about how much Christ loves them.

This weekend we have the Mass of Remembrance at the 5 p.m. Sunday Mass in Wells. Please remember those who have passed away in our communities, especially those who have passed away in the last year. Our prayers and intentions help apply Christ's saving grace to be applied to their soul to help purify them and make them perfect as our Heavenly Father is perfect. In 1954, Congress passes legislation that renamed the federal holiday "Veterans Day", in recognition of the service of veterans of all U.S. Wars.


